
# Meeting Schedule

Show and tell –Tactic TTX650 transmitter was displayed by Pierre Fath. It's a very inexpensive and affordable unit. It has a 20 model memory and costs around \$150. Adding 3 receivers brings the cost up to around \$190. The transmitter works with Flyzone planes, but will fly any plane in your arsenal. It has ball bearing gimbals, large LCD screen, straightforward menus, dual rate trim switch, timer, programmable mixes, auto cut power on and much more.
