Show and tell – Secretary Emanuel Morris showed his landing gear modifications he made to his ParkZone Extra 300. He swapped out the manufactures gear and installed gear from a Yak 55. After cutting and welding the landing gear, it fit perfect in the allowed slot. The gear is angled forward and now accommodates larger wheels. The small plane rolls great and take offs and landings are much better on our grassy field. Pierre Fath's recommendation to place a thin brass strip from the Cowell to the rear of the gear worked out perfect to give the plane a 'leaf spring' type of support which absorbs the shock of hard landings. Before this modification, the landing gear would rip clean off the plane.
