Interference

A couple of us, including myself, have been hit with interference in a spot north of the field. We are all running 2.4 GHz equipment, so that is not the problem. The spot is about ¼ mile north on a line between the pavilion and the white power tower that is on the other side of 370 at about 100 feet altitude. Three different modelers have reported problems in that area with three different brand radios. The radios include Futaba, HiTec and Orange/Turnigy/HobbyKing brands. Just watch out for it and let me know if you have problems so we can share knowledge.

April Meeting Minutes (4/16/2015)

We agreed that if passwords are sent out, it would be acceptable to include them in the description field of emails to club members. In the past, passwords were sent out containing field combinations and used to open pdf's containing member contact lists.

New Business: Next meeting will be at the field. The date will be mentioned on the website. We will meet at Mark Twain Hobby Center if weather is bad.

Show and Tell: Our president talked about the Eagle Tree Guardian 2D/3D flight stabilizer that he picked up in Toledo.

The instructions state that it must be directionally mounted and they also discuss how to set the gain, etc. Prez said that he was interested to see how it does in 3D and that he would start out with 'Low' gain. One of our members said he heard that the unit initially had problems gas engine vibrations. Richard also talked brought an item called the Wood Pecker. It looked like a wall paper scrapper, but the President said it was used on Monokote and UltraKote to allow you to put on color over another without bubbles. It puts tiny holes in the base color which are sanded and ironed out invisibly.
