## October Meeting Minutes (10/13/2016)

The meeting was called to order on 10/13/2016 by our President, Richard Jenkins.

Vice President Doug Sanders made the roll call. At that point, there are 55 members in our club at this time. There were 8 members present again at this month's meeting. We currently have two non flying senior members. There were 20 openings available at the time of the meeting.

Our Treasurer, Mike Dierker, was present and he gave the treasurers report.

There was a motion to accept the Treasurer's report as given. Approved.

#### **Old business:** – None.

We talked about changing the member plaque awards to possibly giving out something else. We still would like to present the awards, but change it up a little. Plaques are a little expensive. Member of the year may be a little expensive. We will consider it next month when we do the voting. At that time, the form of the award will be determined.

Bob Pointe's wife's funeral was held. Bob is still experiencing some effects in his posture from the accident. Don Shelton sent the flowers on behalf of the club. .

Final ruling on the AMA is out. It's about 600 pages if anyone interested. In a nutshell, Richard said, we still should register with the FAA, we are not limited to 400 ft. but you have to maintain line of sight. As mentioned prior, there are restrictions are on flying distances from an airport which don't affect our club.

Richard said we should all take time to read the clubs safety rules. Richard also said that you should put your card on the board when flying.

**New Business:** - The floor was opened up for the nomination of officers for next year. We took a vote to nominate the existing officers. Unanimously, the existing officers will keep our present positions.

**Field report:** Bill McMenamy has been cutting most of the grass, including the area around the grain beans. Cecil suggested putting a sign back up for both gates to be open when you fly. Don Shelton said that the farmer was in the field when it was dark and the gate was closed. Surely it wasn't intentional. Richard will ask in an email if someone wants to take on this project of making/getting a sign.

All the planes have been found that were lost in the corn. One was found using a drone fly over. There were a total of three. The prestigious Boner Award was brought back and placed in the pavilion.

**Safety report:** - Everyone please take off from the field, and not from the parking area!! As mentioned above, we have are constantly reminded to adhere to the clubs safety rules.

**Show and tell:** Vice President Doug Sanders talked about his new E-flite Convergence VTOL (Vertical Take Off and Landing). Purchased from Horizon Hobby, the plane takes off vertically much like the Harrier Jump Jet. It's a delta-wing plane with three brushless motors – two rotating motors on the wing and a fixed-position motor in the tail. The transition from vertical to horizontal flight is done with the flip of a switch and has 'Stability mode' programming to ensure smooth transition. The model is designed to accept FPV camera systems and there is an easily accessible camera bay under the nose of the plane. Feel free to view this plane on YouTube. It's really so cool.

Also, what else is cool is the work stand that Cecil White made me. We've done a lot of flying together this season and this was truly an unexpected surprise blessing!! Thanks a million!!! (See attached photo).
