**September Meeting Minutes (9/13/2020)**

The September meeting was called to order at the field by Vice President Doug Sanders.

**Roll Call** – Doug Sanders made the roll call. There were 9 members present, we have 32 members total so far.

**Treasurers Report** - Jim Benedict gave the treasurers report. Motion was approved.

**Secretary's report** – Approved.

**Safety report** – Frank Eck lost a plane he thought was in the beans northeast of the flying field. Helping in the search were Bill McMenamy, Mike Zina and Mike Lindsey. About 13 hours was spent looking for it. Mike

Lindsey helped with his drone flying over the beans and corn looking for it with no luck. The plane was eventually found nose down in a ditch and had been under water by a man doing some mowing along the road.

**Field report** – Frank Eck added poles along the east edge of the field. They are 10 ft. tall pvc poles using wood dowel stock to attach them in the ground. There is a total of 5 poles which will benefit greatly to the location of planes that crash beyond the field. There was concern that the poles may get in the way of the farmer when the field is harvested. Frank said they are removable right now. He said if the club signs off on the idea of the poles, then they would be anchored with t-posts. He has dowel stock two feet down right now. A strong wind will take bring the poles down. T post have a ninety-degree edge off of it at the bottom. He looked at possibly using half inch rebar. The cones at the field edges are anchored 2 feet. Jerry didn't say yeah or nay to the idea, he was down here with Bill McMenemy. We will look into improving the current flags.

**Old business** – The club is having a fly-in on Saturday Oct 3<sup>rd</sup> with the 10<sup>th</sup> as a backup date in case of bad weather. The motion was approved.
