After using a small hose clamp to secure the plug wire to the spark plug all glitches have vanished like the wind.

**SAFETY GUIDANCE** --- (From the FAA web site)

# To fly under The Exception for Recreational Flyers, you must:

- Have a current registration
- Fly only for recreational purposes
- Follow the safety guidelines of a community-based organization
- Keep your drone within your visual line of sight
- Give way and do not interfere with any manned aircraft
- Fly at or below 400' in controlled airspace and only with prior authorization
- Fly at or below 400' in uncontrolled airspace
- Comply with all airspace restrictions
- Pass The Recreational UAS Safety Test
