To fly under <u>The Exception for Recreational Flyers</u>, you must:

)	Have	a	current	t registration

Fly only for recreational purposes

Follow the safety guidelines of a community based organization

Keep your drone within your visual line of sight

Give way and do not interfere with any manned aircraft

Fly at or below 400' in controlled airspace and only with prior authorization

Fly at or below 400' in uncontrolled airspace
